Big Question: What does it mean and what does it look like to live a holy life?

Big Idea: *When a believer's mind is Heavenly their lives will be holy and their hope unwavering.*

Introduction: *Preparing room for Judah*

Preparing your thoughts *today* for *tomorrow*

- V. #13-14 Know that **ignorance** is not bliss but **blinding**
- V. #15-16 Know that **holiness** is not perfection but **distinction**
- V. #17 Know that **reverent fear of God** is not the same as being terrified of God but **mindful of His judgment.**
- V. #18-19 Know that **you** were **bought** at an **immeasurable price**
- V. #20-21 Know that God is **sovereign** and **seeking you**

Applications: How do I take possession of this message and live it out in my life?

- Be quick to set your mind on Heaven.
- Be careful of where you set your gaze.
- Be mindful of how you use your days.
- Be intentional to reset your focus on Jesus.

Therefore, with minds that are alert and fully sober, set your hope on the grace to be brought to you when Jesus Christ is revealed at his coming.
