**Big Question:** What do we learn from Jesus' turning water into wine?

**Big Idea:** *Jesus' first sign reveals the fullness of His salvation.*

**Introduction:** *Does Jesus give us crumbs or abundance?*

#### **Series Introduction:**

- **Theme Verses:** John 20:30-31 *Jesus performed many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.*

#### **Fundamentals of the Fullness of Jesus' Salvation**

- Jesus' salvation comes to us under no human **obligation**
  - It wasn't His "time" AND Mary His mother had no special place
- Jesus' salvation in its fullness is experienced only in **obedience**
  - "Do whatever He says"
- Jesus' salvation is **overflowingly satisfying**
  - Never-ending best wine... not smoke and mirrors, both not magic and not drunkenness

**Applications:** How do I take possession of this message and live it out in my life?

- Jesus' first miracle was in Cana not in a church (Let's go be the church)
- The world starts with the better and ends with bitter... Jesus turns ordinary to extraordinary
- Man centered cleansing has been replaced by miraculous cleansing (Let's be clear how we enter the Church)

*What Jesus did here in Cana of Galilee was the first of the signs through which he revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him.*
